Parade assembly will be at the **Sallie Bush Community Building**, 10795 Ute Pass Ave.

Use the **West entrance** into GMF from U.S, Hwy 24. Parade route map is attached.

Parade registration 8:30-9:30 a.m.- Pre-Judging at 9:30 a.m. - Parade starts at 10:00 a.m..

Come early for the pancake breakfast at 7 a.m. at the Fire Department (donations accepted). Stay after the parade for fun activities for the entire family around the Lake and Gazebo. We will have a Rubber Duckie race, western gunfight show, live music, arts & craft booths, food booth, Hy-Striker, kid's games, inflatable air slide, kids bouncer, and RC Boat Races.

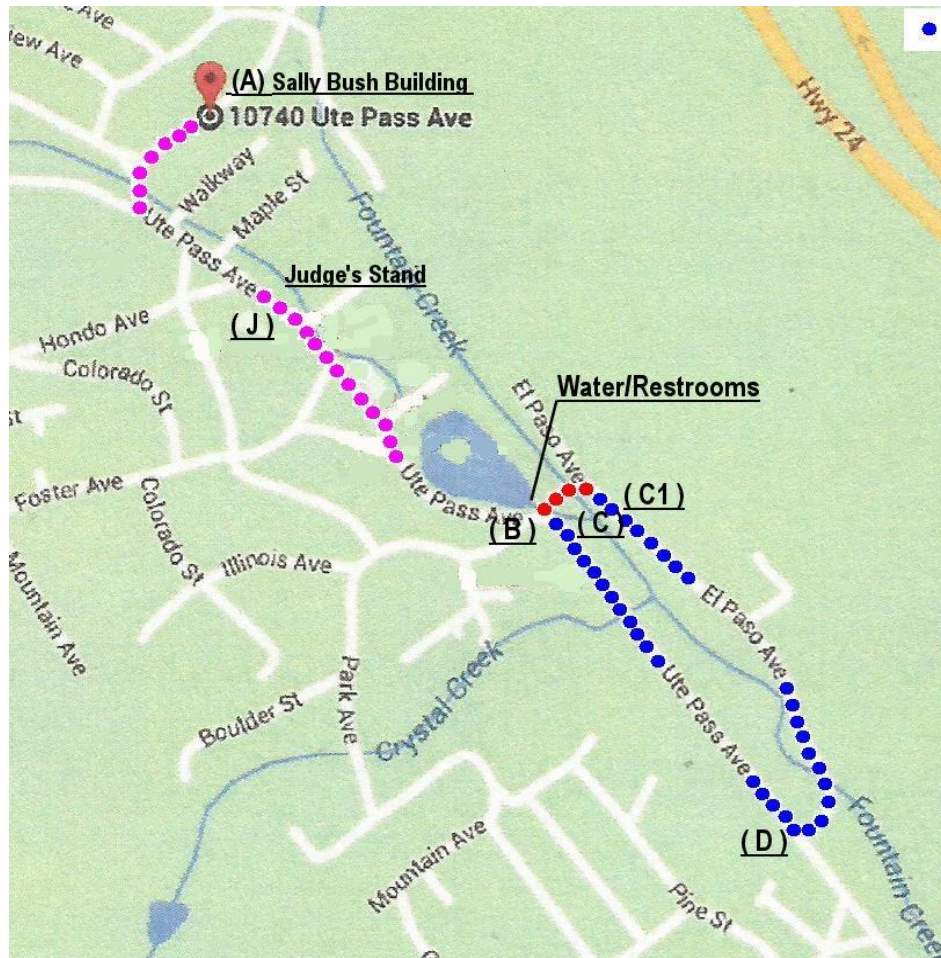

Directions for 78th Bronc Day Parade

July 30, 2016



Register at the Sally Bush Building (A)	8:30-9:30AM
Pre-judging and parade assembly	9:30-10:00AM
Parade starts	10:00AM

The parade route (0.90 mile) will take the entrants past the Judge's stand (J) twice. The Parade Master will direct the parade proceed from the Sally Bush Building (A) to the Eastern most point of the Gazebo Lake (B). At that point, the entrants with the **EVEN** numbered Tags will turn left and proceed across the bridge to point (C) where they will realign on Southern (right) side of El Paso Ave. At point (B) the entrants with the **ODD** numbered Tags will precede straight forward on Ute Pass Ave to point (D). Turning left on to El Paso Ave and continues on the right side of the street to point (C1) and will be aligned numerically.

Once the last entrant has passed point (B), the Parade Master will direct the entrants to proceed back across the bridge, turn right at point (B) and proceed back to the Sally Bush Building. All entrants must pass the Judge's stand twice or be disqualified.

Please note that Bottled Water and Public Restrooms are available to parade entrants at point (B)
